General Guidelines:

- Schedules are utilized to help us facilitate our daily needs. Therefore staff, volunteers and community services persons will be directed by department heads on available shifts. Commonly we are very flexible with volunteer schedules, but it does helps us to know ahead of time when you will be serving.
- Staff does adhere to a work schedule that includes time specific breaks, lunches, etc.;
 please be mindful of this.
- We allow the Holy Spirit to lead us in every aspect of the store's operations. Thus, a servant's attitude of happiness, positive outlook, respect, joy, and willingness to serve is expected.
- If you are a volunteer, please let us know what area of the store God is leading you to serve. We will try our best to accommodate you.
- We do ask that you dress according to the Dress Code:
 - Must wear Calvary Thrift Store shirt and name badge.
 (Calvary Aprons available if you do not have a shirt and badge.)
 - 2. Present yourself in a clean and well-groomed manner.
 - 3. Casual dress is acceptable if it is clean, in good repair, and modest.
 - 4. Closed toe shoes are mandatory.

- Please use courtesy by letting a staff member know when you are arriving or leaving.
- Please respect and follow all store safety policies, such as lifting, using step ladders, be cautious of wet floors, etc.
